General Description of the Position	Plan, prepare and deliver effective learning and teaching programs for every student involved in a particular area of the music curriculum.
Specific Duties and Responsibilities	<ul> <li>In conjunction with Instrumental co-ordinator, determine student and school goals and objectives</li> <li>Teach music theory, aural skills and practical techniques to students</li> <li>Lead guitar ensemble</li> <li>Be punctual to scheduled lessons, practise sessions, recitals, competitions, and other events.</li> <li>Motivate students, especially when they are struggling, and progress is slow.</li> <li>Provide constructive feedback and adjust lessons as required</li> <li>Communicate with parents regarding student progress via phone and email</li> <li>Assess students' ability and write reports</li> <li>All classes are conducted during the school term and teachers/tutors may be required for before/after school rehearsals and concerts.</li> <li>Evaluate and maintain equipment and instruments</li> <li>Provide weekly homework for student practise</li> <li>Report to instrumental coordinator</li> </ul>
