General Description of the Position	Plan, prepare and deliver effective learning and teaching programs for every student involved in a particular area of the music curriculum.
Specific Duties and Responsibilities	 In conjunction with Instrumental co-ordinator, determine student and school goals and objectives Teach music theory, aural skills and practical techniques to students Lead percussion ensemble Be punctual to scheduled lessons, practise sessions, recitals, competitions, and other events. Motivate students, especially when they are struggling, and progress is slow. Provide constructive feedback and adjust lessons as required Communicate with parents regarding student progress via phone and email Assess students' ability and write reports All classes are conducted during the school term and teachers/tutors may be required for before/after school rehearsals and concerts. Evaluate and maintain equipment and instruments Provide weekly homework for student practise Report to instrumental coordinator
