Specific Duties and Responsibilities	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • In conjunction with Instrumental co-ordinator, determine student and school goals and objectives • Teach music theory, aural skills and practical techniques to students • Lead percussion ensemble • Be punctual to scheduled lessons, practise sessions, recitals, competitions, and other events. • Motivate students, especially when they are struggling, and progress is slow. • Provide constructive feedback and adjust lessons as required • Communicate with parents regarding student progress via phone and email • Assess students' ability and write reports • All classes are conducted during the school term and teachers/tutors may be required for before/after school rehearsals and concerts. • Evaluate and maintain equipment and instruments • Provide weekly homework for student practise • Report to instrumental coordinator
