<p>Specific Duties and Responsibilities</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Teach music theory, aural skills, and practical techniques to students. • In conjunction with Instrumental Coordinator, determine student goals and align with College objectives for music. • Lead Drums ensemble. • Be punctual to scheduled lessons, practice sessions, recitals, competitions, and other events. • Encourage students to learn and grow in ability, especially when progress is slow, or motivation is lacking. • Provide constructive feedback and adjust lessons as required. • Communicate with parents regarding student progress via phone and email. • Assess students' ability and write reports. • Conduct tuition during the school term including before/after school rehearsals and concerts. • Evaluate and maintain equipment and instruments. • Provide weekly homework for student practice. • Report regularly on student progress and planning to the Instrumental Coordinator.
